

Vehicle security







Don't leave valuables on show in your car, if you must leave them place them in the boot or covered so they are not visible.

Keep your car locked when you're returning the trolley or chatting to someone in the car park, it's too easy for someone to open a door and reach inside.

Try to use a Park Mark accredited parking facility, these car parks are designed and managed to prevent car crime.

If you use a Sat Nav, GPS navigation or smart phone carrier, always remove it from the windscreen and wipe away the suction mark before you lock the car.

Keep your car and house keys in a secure place away from windows and doors.

Register your car and all its contents with <u>Immobilise.com</u>, a free registration service.

To stop people reaching into your car at road junctions, keep the doors locked and the windows closed.

Fitting a catalytic converter clamp, having it security mark it or welding the converter in place will prevent it's theft.
